Discussion Topics:

Plan: A neighborhood plan: participation/communication
Trailer maintenance
Basic (emergency) necessities to keep in your trailer
Refresher trailer training for you and your animals

Prepare: Set up Emergency Alerts
Learn evacuation routes
Animal Identification (choices)
Notify family/contacts of evacuation plan

Implement: Follow your plan, don't deviate - keep communication open
