VPR's Facility Use Agreement has been updated this month and is posted on our

website. Each month we will highlight a different section.

- 1. Junior Members (under 18 yrs. old) on VPR grounds must always be supervised by a VPR adult member.
- 2. Members must stay on site when horses are stalled.
- Members can bring their dogs on the grounds during <u>Members Only Events</u> and <u>Non-Public days</u>. Dogs must be under the control of the owner on a leash no longer than 6' in length. Dogs may also be contained in a sturdy kennel/crate, camper or horse trailer. Dogs may not be tied on a leash or allowed to run loose. Pick up after your animals.
- 4. Trainers may not conduct individual or group lessons on VPR grounds, even if you are a member.
