**Thursday from 10 am through Monday 12 pm**

- Los Vaqueros Group Horse Campground can accommodate a group of up to 80 people and 45 horses. There is room for about 25 large vehicles/rigs with a maximum length of 50 feet. There is no extra room so please ride share when possible.
- Campers must clean out their own corrals; trailers are supplied for the manure. Dogs must be kept on leashes no longer than 6', in a tent or enclosed vehicle at night and are not allowed on trails.
- You must pick up after your dogs and horses!!!

- *Non-Members \$175 per person includes 1stall*
- *VPR Youth \$140 per person includes 1 stall*
- *VPR Youth under 11 years old No stall-free, with stall-\$30*
